The department includes a post graduate section with an intake of 5 students every year with a course duration of 3 years

The training is aimed at bringing out the good specialists in the branch of Oral and maxillofacial pathology, to evaluate all kinds of lesions in oral and maxillofacial region and diagnose the complex tumors Histo-pathologically, and train in advanced diagnostic procedures.

- Ground sections (10)
 - a) Eight longitudinal (Normal, Attrided, Abraded, Fluorosed)
 - b) Two cross sectional
- Decalcified sections (10 teeth, 10 bone = 20)
 - a) 10 Formic acid
 - b) 10 Nitric acid
- Histology and Oral Pathology records
- All journal club & Seminar soft and hard copy presentations along with duly signed feedback forms
- Thesis and LD copies
- Short Study & Publication
