FIRST YEAR BDS CURRICIULUM

The first year undergraduate students are taught the sciences of DENTAL MATERIALS under which the department of prosthodontics deals with various types of materials that are utilized in the fabrication of removable as well as fixed prosthesis. They will be attending a 1 hour theory class every week in which they are taught the properties and the clinical applications of dental materials that they would be using in their undergraduate course for their clinical postings further. They also have scheduled practical sessions of about 2 hours every week in which they will be given demonstrations and taught to manipulate the materials.

SECOND YEAR BDS CURRICIULUM

The second year undergraduate students as continuation to first year are taught the sciences of DENTAL MATERIALS under which the department of prosthodontics deals with various types of materials that are utilized in the fabrication of removable as well as fixed prosthesis. They will be attending a 1 hour theory class every week in which they are taught the properties and the clinical applications of dental materials that they would be using in their undergraduate course for their clinical postings further. They also have scheduled practical hours of about 2 hours every week in which they will be given demonstrations and taught to manipulate the materials.

Apart from dental materials, second year students also have scheduled 1 hour theory class and 4 and a half hours of practical sessions every week in which they are taught the theoretical and laboratory procedures of complete denture fabrication which solely is a practical exam. They have to practice about 10 teeth arrangements on a mean value articulator as part of the curriculum.

THIRD YER BDS CURRICIULUM

The third year undergraduate students begin with their clinical postings this year during which they are guided by the faculty and taught to fabricate about 4 removable partial dentures and deliver them to the patients .the theoretical part of the removable partial denture is taken in the scheduled 2 hour theory class every week.

FOURTH YEAR BDS CURRICIULUM

The fourth year undergraduate students in their clinical postings this year are guided by the faculty and taught to fabricate about 2 complete dentures and deliver them to the patients .the theoretical part of the complete denture,removable partial denture and fixed dental prosthesis is taken in the scheduled 2 hour theory class every week.

Apart from this they will be attending crown and bridge laboratory for about 2hours every week where they are given demonstrations and taught the clinical procedure of fabrication of a single crown.

INTERNS CURRICIULUM

As a part of their rotary internship interns are posted in the department of prosthodontics for a period of 2 months during which they are trained in diagnosing and formulating a treatment plan. They are exposed to cases and patients on a larger basis and are supposed to fabricate crowns. they are also allowed to assist in the surgical procedures of dental implant placement that are carried out in the department by the post graduate and the faculty.
